

BID Meeting 3-25-21 at Noon

Guests attending the meeting- Neil Putnam, 3 BID applicants (Charlie's Shoe Repair, Brown's Shoe Fit and Ed's Pet World)

Each of the 3 applicants explained what they had planned for their building improvements. The board asked questions. Neil spoke about the difference in contributing and non-contributing buildings in the downtown BID district area. Neil also suggested we work on a flow sheet that could help clear up some confusion when owners are applying for funds, grants, loans etc.

It was decided to award a portion of the funds to each of the applicants with Charlie's Shoe Repair and Ed's Pet World subject to receiving proper documentation regarding city building permits and approval from SHPO.

Funds to be presented to the City to disperse BID monies:

Brown's Shoe Fit- \$10,800.00

Charlie's Shoe Repair- \$11,545.00

Ed's Pet World- \$2,650.00

Total awarded \$24,995.00
