Minutes from June 9 Meeting 2026 at City Hall, 6t12 N. Main St. Mitchell, S.D.

The meeting was called to order by President John Foster at 4 p.m. on Tuesday, June 9th, 2026 in the Mitchell City Council Chambers.

The board was all present except for Morgan and Allen, including Director Dave Sietsema and Assistant Corn Palace Director Craig Stucky. Mayor Hanson also was at the meeting.

Motion to approve the agenda was made by Goldammer and Seconded by Gio to approve the agenda. Motion passed.

Motion to approve the minutes from the April Meeting was made by Goldammer and Seconded by Bates to approve. Motion passed.
